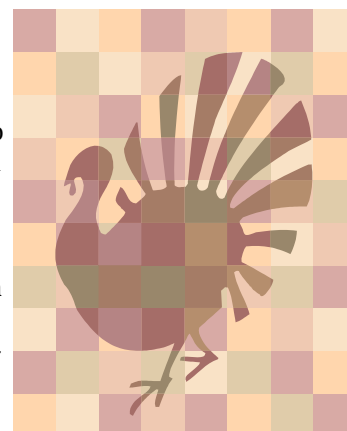
## PRESIDENT'S NOTE

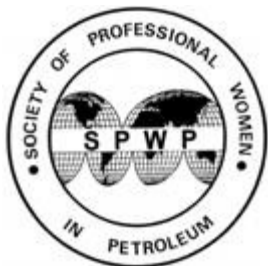
